





What do students need to achieve <u>at school</u> to reach to their goals <u>beyond school</u>?

- UE standard is needed to start a degree course (Yr 13)
- NCEA Level 2 is "useful" for many apprenticeships, and certificate or diploma courses
- Level 1 Literacy and/or Numeracy are required (or at least helpful) for some industries (e.g. some areas of the NZ defence force.)

## WILL STUDENTS GET CREDITS IN YEAR 11?

- L1 Literacy credits
- Numeracy credits
- Skills and understanding to complete NCEA L2 by the end of 2025.
- Some NCEA L1 & 2 credits in some courses.







## WHERE ARE THE CREDITS?

- Credits may be Level 1 or 2
- There may be <u>one standard</u> or <u>none</u> per course
- Some faculties similar over courses (e.g. all Year 11
  PE courses have a 5cr L1 standard) while other
  faculties have different credits in different courses,
  particularly Maths and Science.







## FUTURE PLANNING

- Students to go into some university courses require MORE than just UE standard.
- Students should aim for achieving with Excellence
- Start now aim for work that
  - Is comprehensive
  - Is complex
  - Shows critical thinking


- Teachers to estimate numbers of credits expected
