- does not impede efficient running of the Lynfield College Network
- does not damage Lynfield College's name or reputation.

Lynfield College reserves the right to:

- block, filter, and restrict material which does not comply with the Lynfield College Safe Schools policy or the ICT Code of Conduct
- manage individual devices which use the school network
- respond to a lawful request for information
- restrict, suspend or terminate your access to the Wi-Fi system if you breach the Acceptable Use Policy.

Security:
